A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD APPROVING AND ADOPTING GREENWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT GENERAL ORDERS REGARDING USE OF FORCE/OC SPRAY/IMPACT WEAPONS

WHEREAS, it is important to set written standards of conduct for Police Department officers and employees given their critical role in protecting and serving the community;

WHEREAS, the Police Department has drafted and recommends for adoption General Order 86-G-31 "Use of Force/OC Spray/Impact Weapons" regarding the directive to establish guidelines in the appropriate use of force, a copy of the General Order is attached hereto as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety has reviewed the attached General Orders and believes it is in the best interests of the City to enact them.

NOW THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA THAT:


1. General Order 86-G-31 attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby approved and adopted.




