RESOLUTION NO. 17-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE GREENWOOD COMMON COUNCIL AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT OF THE CDBG PLANNING GRANT APPLICATION TO THE INDIANA OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AND RURAL AFFAIRS AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Greenwood, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits:

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low-and moderate-income persons and/or the elimination of blight; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low-and moderate-income residents:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GREENWOOD COMMON COUNCIL THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor, Mark W. Myers, is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the planning of improvements to the Greenwood Senior Center (d/b/a The Social of Greenwood) and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Section 2. The City of Greenwood, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of Two Thousand Three Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$2,300.00) in the form of funds from The Social of Greenwood, as matching funds for said program, such commitment to contingent upon receipt of CDBG funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.

Section 3. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Resolution are separable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Resolution shall be declared unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality, invalidity, or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and section of this Resolution.
