ORDINANCE NO. 17-57

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2017 SALARY ORDINANCE, COMMON COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 16-50, REGARDING THE CITY COURT DIRECTOR OF COURT OPERATIONS AND ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF COURT OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Greenwood Common Council passed Ordinance 16-50 (the "2017 Salary Ordinance") setting 2017 salaries for all employees;

WHEREAS, the Director of Court Operations position and Assistant Director of Court Operations position are exempt positions eligible for compensatory time under the Municipal Code;

WHEREAS, due to the workload of the positions, each of them accumulates large numbers of compensatory hours throughout the year;

WHEREAS, compensatory time is generally used or lost by employees, with the exception of eighty (80) hours which may be rolled over from year to year and is not paid out;

WHEREAS, the City Court Judge would like the discretion to pay out the Director of Court Operations' and Assistant Director of Court Operations' compensatory time rather than have the positions utilize all of the compensatory time as time off depending upon budget and scheduling needs; and

WHEREAS, no additional appropriation by Council is necessary to fund these changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2017 Salary Ordinance, Common Council Ordinance No. 16-50, Section 2, for the City Court, and Section 17 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 17. The Aquatics Manager position may be eligible for a pay out of compensatory time earned rather than utilizing it as paid time off in the discretion of the Director of Parks and Recreation and Deputy Mayor, depending upon budget and scheduling needs. The Director of Court Operations position and Assistant Director of Court Operations position may be eligible for a pay out of compensatory time earned rather than utilizing it as paid time off in the discretion of the City Court Judge, depending upon budget and scheduling needs. No other positions in the City shall be so eligible."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall have no effect upon any other provisions of Ordinance No. 16-50 except as herein provided, and all other sections of Ordinance No. 16-50 not inconsistent herewith shall remain the same.

Section 3. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases and words of this Ordinance are separable, and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of a Court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality, invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
