ORDINANCE NO. 18-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GREENWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE (1993), AS AMENDED, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 9 "TRASH COLLECTION AND CURBSIDE RECYCLING", SEC. 6-315, TO CHANGE CONTAINER REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood established a trash collection and curbside recycling program for City of Greenwood ("City") residents in 1992, which is codified in the Greenwood Municipal Code (1993), as amended, in Chapter 6, Article 9, Sec 6-305 et seq.;

WHEREAS, the program is administered by the City of Greenwood Board of Public Works and Safety ("Board");

WHEREAS, since the establishment of the program the equipment and manner of collection has changed from a manual collection method to automated collection of specific size containers by truck and it has been difficult to interest contractors to bid for the provision of trash collection services in the City;

WHEREAS, the Board determined it was in the City's best interest to change the specifications of the City's trash collection and curbside recycling program to allow the trash contractor to automate collection by truck through use of specific containers provided to users;

WHEREAS, Greenwood Municipal Code Sec. 6-315 requires users to place trash in plastic or metal containers not larger than 30 gallons and it is necessary to amend GMC Sec. 6-315 to specifically require that users must place trash and recyclable materials in containers provided by the City's trash contractor.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Greenwood Common Council hereby amends Greenwood Municipal Code (1993), as amended, Chapter 6, Article 9, Section 6-315, to specifically provide that users must place trash and recyclables in containers provided by the contractor, as follows:

In the first sentence of the Section by deleting the words "in appropriate plastic or metal containers not larger than 30 gallons in size" and inserting the words "and recyclable materials in containers provided by the contractor" in their place.

Section 2. This Ordinance does not affect any other provisions of the Greenwood Municipal Code (1993), as amended, except as herein provided and all other provisions of the Greenwood Municipal Code (1993), as amended, shall remain the same.

Section 3. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are separable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality, invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.
