

STORMWATER REQUIREMENTS WAIVER REQUEST

Where the City of Greenwood Board of Directors of the Department of Stormwater Management ("Board") finds that there are conditions unique to a property and undue hardships may result from the application of the Stormwater Drainage and Sediment Control regulations and existing Stormwater pollution and/or erosion and Sediment Control facilities are adequate, it may approve waivers to those regulations so that justice will be done and the public safety, health, welfare, and properties of others are secured, provided that such waivers shall not have the effect of preventing the goals and purposes of the regulations, nor result in less effective management of Stormwater runoff or Stormwater quality.

The Board may, in its discretion, grant waivers from the requirements of the Stormwater Drainage and Sediment Control Ordinance ("Ordinance") and/or the Stormwater Technical Manual ("Manual") upon finding that the following four criteria have been met:

- (1) The granting of the waiver will not be detrimental to the public safety, health, or welfare, or injurious to other property;
- (2) The conditions upon which the request for a waiver is based are unique to the property for which a waiver is sought and are not applicable generally to other property;
- (3) The Application of the Ordinance and/or Manual will present or cause undue hardship for a Development or Development site; provided, however, that undue hardship shall not include the need for the Developer to incur reasonable expenses in order to comply with the Ordinance and/or Manual; and
- (4) The granting of the requested relief will not substantially prevent the goals and purposes of the Ordinance, nor result in less effective management of Stormwater Runoff or Stormwater Quality.
