Tiny T-Ball Game Rules

Because young players are still learning the rules of the game, Tiny T-Ball has adopted the following Game Rules:

- ✓ Each player will bat each inning. All batters hit off the tee. We do not pitch in this league. Have parents monitor a “dugout” for safety.
- ✓ The batter will run to first base on the first good hit as established by the coach at the plate. The coach should call “foul ball” on poor hits that just dribble in front of the plate to keep defensive players from swarming in on the ball.
- ✓ Have each player run to first base on an infield hit and to second base on an outfield hit.
- ✓ Have the last batter circle the bases.
- ✓ We play as many innings as time allows.
- ✓ Have your defensive players field the ball and throw it to first base, even if the batter is already at the base. In the unlikely event that we do make an “out,” the batter stays on first base.
- ✓ Have parents stand on the field with their child to direct and encourage them.
- ✓ If the ball is constantly being hit to one area, switch your defensive players around during an inning so that everyone gets a chance to field the ball.
- ✓ A catcher is not needed in this league.
