The information which follows and the accompanying plans, specifications and other information with the representations therein contained, are made a part of this application in reliance upon which the Planning Commission of the City of Greenwood is requested to issue a location improvement permit.

It is understood and agreed by this Applicant that any error, misstatement or misrepresentation of material fact, either with or without intention on the part of this Applicant, such as might or would operate to cause refusal of this application, or conditional approval thereof, or any material alteration or change in the accompanying plans, specifications or improvements subsequent to the issuance of a permit in accordance with the application, without the approval of the Planning Commission shall constitute sufficient ground for the revocation of this permit.

All building construction work, alterations, repairs, or mechanical installations and appliances connected therewith and other work necessary to complete the following improvement, shall comply with the State Building Rules and Regulations, local ordinances and such other statutory provisions pertaining to this class of work, and such rules, regulations, ordinances and provisions shall be considered a part of specifications, whether specified herein or not.

#### State Variance Required for Tents to remain Standing Longer than 30 Days

In Greenwood, we permit temporary structures (tents) for 60 days and those permits can be renewed every 60 days. The State of Indiana, however, only allows temporary membrane structures (tents) to remain erect for a period of 30 days. This conflict can be accommodated, however, by requesting a variance from the State of Indiana Department of Homeland Security. The code reference you would request a variance from is "Indiana Fire Code 2012 3103.5". Please see the copied text from the code section as well as the 675 IAC amendments below. The Indiana amendment reduces the period in which the tent may remain.

**2012 Indiana Fire Code 3103.5 Use period.** *Temporary tents, air-supported, air inflated or tensioned membrane structures shall not be erected for a period of more than 180 days within a 12-month period on a single premises.* 

675 IAC 22-2.5-24 Chapter 31; tents and other membrane structures

**Authority: IC 22-13-2-2** 

Affected: IC 22-12-7; IC 22-13; IC 22-14; IC 36-8-17 Sec. 24. Chapter 31 is amended as follows: (a) Amend Section 3101.1 to delete the text and insert the following: Except as otherwise provided in Sections 3104.7, 3104.15.5, and 3104.15.6, tents and membrane structures having an area in excess of 400 square feet shall be in accordance with Chapter 31. (f) Amend Section 3103.5 to delete "180" and insert "thirty (30)".

Therefore, for tents that are to remain standing for longer than 30 days, a variance must be obtained from the State of Indiana at https://www.in.gov/dhs/boards-and-commissions/variances/.
