ORDINANCE NO. 22-29

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY OF THE CITY JUDGE OF THE CITY OF
GREENWOOD, INDIANA FOR THE YEAR 2023**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-4-7-2 the Common Council shall, by ordinance, fix the annual compensation of all elected city officers;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA:

Section 1. The City fund(s) from which compensation is to be paid is indicated following the salary. The funds are abbreviated as followed: General Fund (“GF”) and Adult Probation Services (“D”).

Section 2. That from and after the first day of January, 2023, the salary and pay schedule for the City Judge of the City of Greenwood, Indiana, continuing until duly changed, shall be fixed as follows:

Position	# of Positions	Bi-Weekly Salary	Fund GF	Fund D
City Court Judge	1	\$4,394.26	80%	20%

Section 3. That from and after the first day of January, 2023, the City Judge may receive, in addition to the above salary, the following additional compensation.

a) The City Judge may receive reimbursement for actual direct expenses, including reimbursement for miles traveled on City business in a personal vehicle at the rate established pursuant to written Board of Public Works and Safety Resolutions and meals and lodging incurred while attending seminars, conferences, workshops pursuant to written Board of Public Works and Safety Resolutions, and other business which promotes the betterment of the City and furthers the education and training of City officials in accordance with Greenwood Municipal Code Sec. 2-96 and which are consistent with audit positions of the State Board of Accounts.

b) The City Judge is generally eligible to receive other benefits that are available to City employees.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval according to law.
