ORDINANCE NO. 22-35

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FROM
THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY
FUND TO BUDGET CLASSIFICATION 439 (\$1,000,000) FOR SECURITY GRANTS TO
LOCAL PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS OPERATING WITHIN THE CITY OF
GREENWOOD**

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood (“City”) has received its full allocation of American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) funds;

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of the Treasury Final Rule to implement the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (“Final Rule”) allows the use of ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (“Fund”) money to be used to provide government services to the extent of reduction in revenue, which reduction is presumed to have been due to the COVID-19 public health emergency;

WHEREAS, the Rule further provides that government services for which Fund money may be spent includes the provision of safety and security equipment and programs;

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends that the City establish a One Million Dollar (\$1,000,000) grant program to be divided and disbursed evenly among the three public school corporations located within the City: Greenwood Community School Corporation, Clark Pleasant Community School Corporation, and Center Grove Community School Corporation, for the purpose of funding security equipment or security programs;

WHEREAS, the grant program will be operated as a reimbursement grant, requiring the recipient of grant funds to submit to the City Controller (“Controller”) for review an invoice for reimbursement of costs of qualified purchases or expenses with appropriate documentation of the items or programs funded, and the Controller must approve the request before payment is made;

WHEREAS, the Controller has determined that the Fund has a sufficient balance available to fund the school security grant program;

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to make the requested additional appropriation for the school security grant program, and shall hold a public hearing regarding the appropriation in accordance with law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, THAT:


Section 1. For the expenses of the City of Greenwood, the following additional sum of money is hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the fund herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

<u>ARP CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND (FUND 176)</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Other Services and Charges - 439	\$1,000,00.00

Said sum is to be used for expenditures of the type and kind permitted by law.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.


