ORDINANCE NO. 22-36

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS WITHIN THE PARKS FUND FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FROM BUDGET CATEGORIES 444 (\$137,100) AND 449 (\$32,900) TO BUDGET CATEGORY 439

WHEREAS, funds may be transferred from one major budget category to another major budget category within a fund by ordinance of the fiscal body at a public meeting without advertising a public hearing if no additional appropriations are required;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to transfer certain funds in the Parks and Recreation Department Budget allocated for improvements other than buildings and other capital outlays to other services and charges, to cover increased utility costs due to major maintenance and repairs at Freedom Springs Aquatic Park and to cover deficits in the budget for additional required maintenance, including the replacement of the Community Center roof;

WHEREAS, no additional appropriation is necessary to accommodate these changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1: For the expenses of the City of Greenwood, and its institutions for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, the City of Greenwood hereby determines the transfer of the following sums of money to be necessary and the following sums are hereby transferred and ordered set apart out of the funds herein named subject to the laws governing the same:
