**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 22-20, A RESOLUTION
RECOGNIZING REVEREND DAVID MARK OWEN FOR HIS YEARS OF SERVICE,
TO CORRECT TYPOGRAPHICAL ERRORS**

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood previously adopted Resolution 22-20 recognizing Reverend David Mark Owen for his years of service as President of the Johnson County Ministerial Association and for his service to the community ("Res. 22-20");

WHEREAS, Reverend Owen's name was incorrect and the name of the Otterbein Franklin Senior Life Community was incorrect in the text of the resolution;

WHEREAS, Res. 22-20 should be amended to correct these typographical errors, and the Greenwood Common Council has determined it is necessary to correct the typographical errors and to direct the Greenwood Common Council President to execute Res. 22-20, as amended,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GREENWOOD COMMON COUNCIL THAT:

Section 1. Greenwood Common Council Resolution 22-20, "A Resolution of the Greenwood Common Council Recognizing Reverend Mark David Owens for His Years of Service as President of the Johnson County Ministerial Association", is hereby amended in the caption and throughout the text of the Resolution to correct the name "Mark David Owens" to "David Mark Owen"; and to correct the name "Otterbein Franklin" in the Sixth "Whereas" clause to "Otterbein Franklin Senior Life Community".


Section 2. The Greenwood Common Council President is directed to sign Resolution 22-20, as amended.
