ORDINANCE NO. 23-41

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FROM
THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY
FUND TO BUDGET CLASSIFICATION 445 (\$36,814) FOR AIR PURIFICATION
SYSTEM FOR THE CITY EMPLOYEE HEALTH CLINIC**

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood ("City") has received its full allocation of American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) funds;

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of the Treasury Final Rule to implement the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund ("Final Rule") allows the use of ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund ("Fund") money to be used to provide government services to the extent of reduction in revenue, which reduction is presumed to have been due to the COVID-19 public health emergency;

WHEREAS, the Rule further provides that government services for which Fund money may be spent includes the provision of equipment;

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends investment in a Germ and Virus Elimination Device air purification system for the City of Greenwood Employee Health and Wellness Center ("Clinic") located in the City Center Building, to promote the health and welfare of the employees who utilize the Clinic, the citizens of the City who visit the City Center Building, and the employees who work there;

WHEREAS, the City Controller requests an additional appropriation from the Fund in the amount of Thirty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fourteen and no/100 Dollars (\$36,814.00) to budget classification Capital Outlay – 445 Machinery and Equipment to purchase and install the Germ and Virus Elimination Device air purification system at the Clinic;

WHEREAS, the Controller has determined that the Fund has a sufficient balance available to fund the purchase and installation;

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to make the requested additional appropriation, and shall hold a public hearing regarding the appropriation in accordance with law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. For the expenses of the City of Greenwood, the following additional sum of money is hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the fund herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

<u>ARP CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND (FUND 176)</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Capital Outlay – 445 Machinery and Equipment	\$36,814.00

Said sum is to be used for expenditures of the type and kind permitted by law.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.




