RESOLUTION NO. 24-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD SETTING PARKING RATES FOR SPECIAL EVENT PARKING AT MUNICIPAL PARKING FACILITIES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-9-11-7 the Board of Public Works and Safety (the "Board") is responsible for the supervision and operation of the City of Greenwood Municipal Parking Facilities (the "Facilities");

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-9-11-7 the Board may fix the rates and charges to be collected for the parking of vehicles, or for any other use of the facility, and adopt rules governing the use and operation of the facility so as to promote the maximum use of the facility by the public in a safe, orderly, and efficient manner, said rates, charges, and rules becoming effective upon approval of the Greenwood Common Council;

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood frequently has special events, defined as a festival, gathering, event, fair or meeting organized or arranged for purposes of sport, exhibition, trade, commerce, entertainment, music industry or any other purposes that may occur periodically;

WHEREAS, one such special event is the Solar Eclipse occurring on April 8, 2024 where it is anticipated that observers will use the City of Greenwood Park and Recreation Facilities highlighted on Attachment A so as to facilitate viewing the eclipse;

WHEREAS, the Board recommends the Greenwood Common Council set special event parking rates for all Facilities;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that special event rates and charges for parking and other services are reasonable and designed to bring in revenues sufficient to cover the cost of providing and operating the Facilities during special events;

NOW THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA THAT:

1. The Board recommends acceptance and setting of parking rates for special events at certain amounts determined by the Board, not to exceed Forty Dollars (\$40.00), for each single calendar day the special event occurs, subject to parking restrictions contained within the Greenwood Municipal Code to the Greenwood Common Council.

2. Upon adoption of the amendments to Greenwood Municipal Code (1993), Chapter 8, Traffic and Parking Regulations, Article 4, Parking Regulations, Section 8-32 by the Common Council for the City of Greenwood, the parking rate for the Facilities highlighted on Attachment A will be set at Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day for the Solar Eclipse special event occurring on April 8, 2024.
