## **RESOLUTION NO. 24-04**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 24-02 SETTING PARKING RATES FOR SPECIAL EVENT PARKING AT MUNICIPAL PARKING FACILITIES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code §36-9-11-7 the Board of Public Works and Safety (the "Board") is responsible for the supervision and operation of the City of Greenwood Municipal Parking Facilities (the "Facilities");

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code §36-9-11-7 the Board may fix the rates and charges to be collected for the parking of vehicles, or for any other use of the facility, and adopt rules governing the use and operation of the facility so as to promote the maximum use of the facility by the public in a safe, orderly, and efficient manner, said rates, charges, and rules becoming effective upon approval of the Greenwood Common Council;

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood frequently has special events, defined as a festival, gathering, event, fair or meeting organized or arranged for purposes of sport, exhibition, trade, commerce, entertainment, music industry or any other purposes that may occur periodically;

WHEREAS, the Board recommended to the Greenwood Common Council that it set special event parking rates and the Greenwood Common Council set special event parking rates on March 18, 2024 by adoption of Ordinance 24-15, which authorized the Board, in its discretion, to set special event parking rates at an amount not to exceed Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day;

WHEREAS, at its March 18, 2024 meeting, the Board adopted Resolution 24-02, which, in part, set the parking rate at Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day for the Solar Eclipse special event occurring on April 8, 2024;

WHEREAS, the Board now seeks to amend Paragraph 2 of Resolution 24-02 setting the amount at Forty Dollars (\$40.00) for the Facilities highlighted in Attachment A to an amount *not to exceed* Forty Dollars (\$40.00);

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that special event rates and charges for parking and other services are reasonable and designed to bring in revenues sufficient to cover the cost of providing and operating the Facilities during special events.

NOW THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA THAT:

1. Paragraph 2 of Resolution 24-02 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Upon adoption of the amendments to Greenwood Municipal Code (1993), Chapter 8, Traffic and Parking Regulations, Article 4, Parking Regulations, Section 8-32 by the Common Council for the City of Greenwood, the parking rate for the Facilities highlighted on Attachment A will be set at an amount *not to exceed* Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day for the Solar Eclipse special event occurring on April 8, 2024.
