## **ORDINANCE NO. 25-03**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 SALARY ORDINANCE, COMMON COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 24-27, TO ADD PART-TIME MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTH COORDINATOR POSITION IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Greenwood Common Council passed Ordinance 24-27, "An Ordinance Fixing Salaries of Appointed Officers and Employees of the City of Greenwood, Indiana and City Utilities for the Year 2025" (the "2025 Salary Ordinance"), setting 2025 salaries for all employees and stating whether each position is exempt or non-exempt;

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief requests the addition of one part-time Mobile Integrated Health Coordinator position in the Fire Department to provide support to community members who receive health-related emergency services and to facilitate community resources for those persons;

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that this position will result in a decrease in Fire Department calls for emergency services that are related to social service assistance needs;

WHEREAS, the 2025 Salary Ordinance requires amendment to add the part-time position of the Mobile Integrated Health Coordinator in the Fire Department;

WHEREAS, the position will be funded by the Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund and there exist sufficient unobligated funds currently to compensate the Mobile Integrated Health Coordinator position, and an additional appropriation will be requested to create a salary budget within the Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund in an amount necessary to fund the amendment;

WHEREAS, the 2025 Salary Ordinance requires amendment to include the Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund as a fund from which salary or wage compensation may be paid;

WHEREAS, the part-time Mobile Integrated Health Coordinator position is a non-exempt position eligible for overtime compensation under the Municipal Code,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2025 Salary Ordinance, Common Council Ordinance No. 24-27, Section 1., second sentence, is hereby amended by deleting the word "and" that appears before the words "Aviation Operation ("A",) and inserting a comma and the words "Opioid Settlement Restricted ("OSR") after the parenthetical ("A") at the end of the sentence.

Section 2. The 2025 Salary Ordinance, Common Council Ordinance No. 24-27, Section 3, Fire, is hereby amended to add the part-time position of Mobile Integrated Health Coordinator in the Fire Department, as follows:

Section 3. This Ordinance shall have no effect upon any other provisions of Ordinance No. 24-27 except as herein provided, and all other sections of Ordinance No. 24-27 not inconsistent herewith shall remain the same.

Section 4. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases and words of this Ordinance are separable, and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable by the valid judgment or

this Ordinance. Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
