**RESOLUTION NO. 25-03**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GREENWOOD COMMON COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE  
FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR, THE ACCEPTANCE OF, AND  
IMPLEMENTATION OF, 2025 COUNTY LOCAL DRUG-FREE COMMUNITIES FUND  
GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,474.00 WITH THE DRUG FREE JOHNSON  
COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Drug Free Johnson County is now accepting applications for the 2025 County Local Drug-Free Communities Fund Grant, which provides grant funds for prevention/education, law enforcement/justice, and intervention/treatment.

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood Police Department desires to apply for grant funds to reduce substance use by middle school youth and high school youth, and increase enforcement of alcohol and drug related offenses by 1% by 2025;

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood may receive grant funds in the amount of Nine Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars and 00/100 (\$9,474.00);

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood Police Department intends to use the Grant funds toward the renewal of the license with Cellebrite USA, LLC and to purchase certain equipment related to narcotics investigations;

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood shall apply for the 2025 County Local Drug-Free Communities Fund Grant to receive the funds to reduce substance use by middle school youth and high school youth, and increase enforcement of alcohol and drug related offenses and the City of Greenwood Police Department is the fiscal agent and is responsible for applying for and administering the Grant;

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood desires to apply for the 2025 County Local Drug-Free Communities Fund Grant and to authorize the acceptance and implementation of the Grant as now contemplated for the purpose described herein; and

WHEREAS, it is required that the City of Greenwood enter into various contracts and agreements and authorizes the execution and filing of said Grant application and supporting documents that are necessary or convenient for the receipt of said Grant funds if said terms and conditions are satisfied.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GREENWOOD COMMON COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Greenwood, Indiana, hereby authorizes the filing of an application for, and acceptance and implementation of, 2025 County Local Drug-Free Communities Fund Grant, further authorizes all other convenient or necessary agreements and documents related to acceptance, implementation and administration of said 2025 County Local Drug-Free Communities Fund Grant, and that such funds received from the Grant will be made available for the purpose of reducing substance use by middle school youth and high school youth, and increasing enforcement of alcohol and drug related offenses.

Section 2. Mark Myers, Mayor of the City of Greenwood, Indiana, and/or James Ison, Chief of Police of the Greenwood Police Department, are hereby empowered and authorized to act and execute on behalf of the City, any and all convenient or necessary contracts, agreements, and documents required in the obtaining and expenditure of said 2025 County Local Drug-Free Communities Fund Grant.


Section 3. All actions heretofore taken in furtherance of the filing of the 2025 County Local Drug-Free Communities Fund Grant application are hereby ratified.

Section 4. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases and words of this

Resolution are separable, and if any word, phrases clauses sentence paragraph or section of this Resolution shall be declared unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable by the valid judgment of decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality, invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Resolution.

Section 5. The Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Greenwood, Indiana.


