ORDINANCE NO. 25-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 SALARY ORDINANCE, COMMON COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 24-27, TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT POSITION AND ELIMINATE THE PERMIT TECHNICIAN/ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT POSITION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Greenwood Common Council passed Ordinance 24-27, "An Ordinance Fixing Salaries of Appointed Officers and Employees of the City of Greenwood, Indiana and City Utilities for the Year 2025" (the "2025 Salary Ordinance"), setting 2025 salaries for all employees and stating whether each position is exempt or non-exempt;

WHEREAS, as part of a reorganization of the Department of Community Development Services a Cityworks Administrator position was created which necessitated changing duties and responsibilities of various positions to apportion duties that were performed by the former Cityworks/Administrative Support position, and an additional Administrative Assistant position is needed to effectuate the reorganization, but the Permit Technician/Administrative Support Position is no longer needed;

WHEREAS, the 2025 Salary Ordinance requires amendment to increase the number of Administrative Assistant positions from one (1) to two (2) and to eliminate the Permit Technician/Administrative Support position in the Department of Community Development Services;

WHEREAS, there exist unobligated funds in the Department of Community Development Services salary budget to compensate the two (2) Administrative Assistant positions, and no additional appropriation by the Common Council is necessary to fund the amendments;

WHEREAS, the Administrative Assistant position is a non-exempt position eligible for overtime compensation under the Municipal Code,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2025 Salary Ordinance, Common Council Ordinance No. 24-27, Section 2, Community Development Services, is hereby amended to delete the Permit Technician/Administrative Support position and increase the number of Administrative Assistant positions from one (1) to two (2), in the Department of Community Development Services, as follows:

Section 2. This Ordinance shall have no effect upon any other provisions of Ordinance No. 24-27 except as herein provided, and all other sections of Ordinance No. 24-27 not inconsistent herewith shall remain the same.

Section 3. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases and words of this Ordinance are separable, and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of a Court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality, invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance.
