## **RESOLUTION NO. 25-05**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF SURPLUS PROPERTY TO THE NEEDHAM COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety (the "Board") is a duly organized and existing political subdivision of the City of Greenwood, State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana law, the Board of Public Works and Safety is authorized to sell or gift surplus property firefighting or emergency services equipment to a volunteer fire department;

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood Fire Department Chief has advised the Board that the Greenwood Fire Department has surplus firefighting equipment in the form of an electric stair chair ("Property") and the Chief seeks to donate or gift the Property to the Needham Community Volunteer Fire Department for use by that Department;

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief therefore recommends, and the Board hereby finds and recommends, that the donation of the Property to the Needham Community Volunteer Fire Department is appropriate when considering the current needs and operations of the City of Greenwood Fire Department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA THAT:

Section 1. The Chief of the City of Greenwood Fire Department, acting on behalf of the Board, is hereby authorized to donate or gift the Property to the Needham Community Volunteer Fire Department. This authorization also delegates to the Chief of the Greenwood Fire Department the authority to execute any related and incidental contracts, agreements, or documents.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its approval and adoption.
