

### **Stormwater**

Greenwood's stormwater system manages the runoff from rainfall. In nature, water flows from fields to streams to rivers and other waterways, but development impacted these natural flows. The stormwater system helps to prevent flooding and limits pollutants from flowing into streams and rivers.

Stormwater bills are sent to property owners quarterly (4 times per year).

The Chinkapin or Chinquapin Oak is a deciduous tree in the white oak group. A mature tree will reach about 70 feet with a 30 foot canopy. 


