

Greenwood Fire Department Job Posting

Career Firefighter/EMT

The Greenwood Fire Department will have applications available via email for the position of Career Firefighter/EMT starting at 8:00 a.m. on Monday July 18, 2022. An application can be requested by emailing Greenwood Fire Department Administrative Assistants Kim Hamilton at hamiltoh@greenwood.in.gov or Kelly McGraw at McGrawk@greenwood.in.gov at Fire Department Headquarters. The application packet must be returned in person no later than 2:30 p.m. on Friday July 29, 2022. No exceptions. There is a \$25 fee (Cash Only) when the application is dropped off at Greenwood Fire Headquarters at 155 E. Main Street Greenwood, IN 46143.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 21 Years of age at the time of conditional offer, but not have reached your 36th birthday in accordance with the 1977 Police Officers' and Firefighters' Pension Fund
- Indiana State Certified Firefighter I/II and EMT-B
- Valid Indiana Driver's License

The complete job description and minimum qualifications will be given to you in the GFD Hiring Packet when application is returned to Greenwood Fire Department.

This hiring process will be used to develop an eligibility list to hire career firefighters for any immediate and future openings in the next two (2) years.

A schedule of the hiring process components is included in the application packet. The dates and times listed in the packet are the only ones available; there are no makeup dates available. The first scheduled component is the written test. The date for the written test is Monday August 8, 2022.
