4th Amendment to the 2019 Action Plan for CARES Act Funding (CDBG-CV)

This notice provides the public an opportunity to examine and comment on the Program Year 2021 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER). This document provides an overview of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program for the year ending September 30, 2022. This document will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on December 22, 2022.

The CAPER will be available for public view from December 5, 2022, through December 21, 2022 on the CDBG webpage of the City of Greenwood (www.greenwood.in.gov/cdbg). Upon request, the CAPER will be emailed to individual parties. In addition to the CAPER document, the City of Greenwood is amending its 2019 Action Plan to reallocate unused CDBG-CV funding. The City of Greenwood has received an allocation of \$515,699 of CDBG Coronavirus funding, of which \$131,663 has been returned from projects unable to utilize the funds. This remaining funding, through the 4th amendment, will be reallocated to the Northeast Park Shelter project. The amendment will be available for public view from December 5, 2022, through December 10, 2022 on the CDBG webpage of the City of Greenwood (www.greenwood.in.gov/cdbg). Upon request, the amendment will be emailed to individual parties. The City will host a public hearing on the City's CDBG program, including the CAPER and the 4th Amendment to the 2019 Action Plan on December 5, 2022 at 12:00 pm in the Greenwood City Council Chambers at 300 South Madison Avenue. The City will also utilize this public hearing to solicit input from the public on the best use of funding opportunities to improve affordable housing opportunities and social services in the community for its 2023 Action Plan.
