

GREENWOOD COMMON COUNCIL

ORDINANCE NO. 24-18

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND TO BUDGET CLASSIFICATION 431 (\$2,450,914) AND THE CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND TO BUDGET CLASSIFICATION 431 (\$187,200)

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood (“City”) received its allocation of American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (ARP Fund), and the U.S. Department of the Treasury final rule to implement the ARP Fund (“Final Rule”) allows fund money to be used to provide government services to the extent of reduction in revenue presumed to have been due to the COVID-19 public health emergency;

WHEREAS, the Final Rule further provides that government services for which ARP Fund money may be spent includes costs for the performance of public improvement projects;

WHEREAS, the City Engineer advises that funds are needed to cover the professional services costs of the Market Plaza improvement project in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Nine Dollars (\$1,585,669.00);

WHEREAS, the City Engineer further advises that funds are needed for right-of-way acquisition services for the Main Street Segment 1 & 2 improvement project in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$228,445.00), and that funds are needed to hire a consultant to design the Main Street Segments 3 & 4 improvement project in the amount of Six Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$636,800.00);

WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends the City hire a consultant to conduct a Road Impact Fee Study at a cost of One Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$187,200.00), said cost being eligible for reimbursement from Road Impact Fees if the City adopts fees following the study;

WHEREAS, the City Controller has determined that the ARP Fund has a sufficient balance available to fund a portion of the professional services and requests an additional appropriation from the ARP Fund in the amount of Two Million Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen and no/100 Dollars (\$2,450,914.00) to ARP Fund budget classification Other Services and Charges 431- Professional Services, to cover the professional services costs of the Market Plaza improvement project in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Nine Dollars (\$1,585,669.00), the costs of the right-of-way acquisition services for the Main Street Segment 1 & 2 improvement project in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$228,445.00), and the costs of the design of the Main Street Segments 3 & 4 improvement project in the amount of Six Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$636,800.00);

WHEREAS, the City Controller has determined that the Cumulative Capital Development Fund has a sufficient balance available to fund the professional services for the Road Impact Fee Study and the City Controller requests an additional appropriation in the amount of One Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$187,200.00) to CCD- Cumulative Capital Development Fund budget classification Other Services and Charges 431 – Professional Services to cover the costs of the Road Impact Fee Study;

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to make the additional appropriations and shall hold a public hearing in accordance with law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. For the expenses of the City of Greenwood, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the fund herein named and for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws governing the same:

ARP CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND

Other Services and Charges – 431 Professional Services \$2,450,914.00

CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND

Other Services and Charges – 431 Professional Services \$ 187,200.00

Said sums are to be used for expenditures of the type and kind permitted by law.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
