



**Public Information Meeting**  
**Smith Valley Road, Segment 1 Widening Project**  
**From Browning Drive to 345 feet west of U.S. 31**

The City of Greenwood will host a public information meeting for the proposed Smith Valley Road, Segment 1 widening project, extending from Browning Drive to 345 feet west of U.S. Highway 31 in Greenwood, Johnson County, Indiana (Des. No. 2421FFE). The meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to learn more about the project, talk with project team members, and view project materials.

The project is needed to address increasing traffic volumes along Smith Valley Road. According to a feasibility study completed in July 2023, this section of roadway is already experiencing congestion, and traffic conditions are expected to worsen as travel demand continues to grow.

**What:** Public information meeting for improvements along Smith Valley Road. from Browning Drive to 345 Ft. West of U.S. Highway 31.

**When:** Thursday, June 11, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. (doors open at 5:30 p.m.)

**Where:** Greenwood City Center, 300 S. Madison Ave., Greenwood, IN 46142

Doors will open at **5:30 p.m.**, giving the public an opportunity to view project displays and speak with project representatives. A brief presentation will begin at **6:00 p.m.**, followed by an open house with the opportunity to converse with the project team. Comment forms will be available for attendees to provide feedback on the proposed improvements.
