

GREENWOOD COMMON COUNCIL

ORDINANCE NO. 15-44

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING EVERGREEN STREET A ONE-WAY SOUTH STREET

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 9-21-1-3(a)(4) provides local authorities with jurisdiction to designate roadways within their boundaries as one-way streets;

WHEREAS, the City is constructing a roundabout at the intersection of Main Street and Averitt Road to reduce traffic congestion;

WHEREAS, the ability of drivers turning from Evergreen Street onto Main Street will be hindered due to sight line and distance;

WHEREAS, the City has considered several safety options for Evergreen Street, including maintaining two-way traffic (current condition), making Evergreen Street one-way in the south direction, and eliminating the intersection of Evergreen Street with Main Street;

WHEREAS, the City contacted the 31 property owners in the Westview Addition to determine if there was a preference significantly greater than the others;

WHEREAS, the 12 respondents to the survey were evenly split between the three options; and

WHEREAS, the City determined a one-way south designation for Evergreen Street would require the least amount of right-of-way, preclude requiring relocation of a resident, and continue to provide property owners with access to Westview Addition from Main Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. Evergreen Street is hereby declared a one-way street for southbound traffic.

Section 2. Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions. All ordinances and resolution and parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions., or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of the ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.






